PHASE 3: ROAD REHABILITATION



PRECONSTRUCTION SAFETY MEETING - MARCH 28, 2017

Schedule:

1. Construction to begin on or After May 1, 2017
2. Work will begin between 800 N and 1000 N.
3. The road will be closed to thru traffic
4. During construction there will be times where access to businesses or residents will only be maintained from one direction
5. Updates will be provided via a monthly newsletter, website, facebook, and twitter.

Safety Notes:

1. The road is open for local traffic only. This means unless you are visiting a specific business or residence inside of the project limits, you should use the posted detour for vehicular traffic or another route for buggy traffic. Limiting traffic on the construction site can significantly speed up the project.
2. If it is necessary to travel through the construction site please use caution. If traveling by vehicle drive slowly and be aware of construction equipment and workers who may not be able to see you. If traveling by buggy, try to make visual eye contact with equipment operators before proceeding past. This will allow the equipment operator to make room for buggy traffic to pass minimizing the possibility of spooking a horse.
3. Pay attention to barricades. There will be times during construction that additional barricades are in place to prevent all traffic from proceeding. This could occur when a pipe is being placed or and intersection is being worked on. Please do not move barricades that block the entire road.
4. When the concrete pavement is being placed it is essential that traffic avoids the construction site. This will allow the concrete to be placed and cured properly and eliminate the possibility of damaging new concrete.
5. Amish Schools and children. If there are alternate routes for school children to use during construction, we would highly recommend children staying out of the construction area.
6. Advance notice of events that might require traveling thru the construction site would be appreciated and efforts will be made to accommodate the events if possible. Examples: Church Services, Funerals, etc.
