

Today's COVID-19 update Friday, March 20, 2020 @ 3:55 pm:

EFFECTIVE CLOSE OF BUSINESS TODAY (March 20, 2020) BY ORDER OF THE DAVIESS COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE:

All hair/cosmetology salons, nail salons, spas, tattoo parlors, tanning salons, barbershops, massage therapy services, acupuncture services, and the like are required to limit clients to one at a time for service. If your facility is set up for multiple stations, you will be allowed one client per station AS LONG AS THEY ARE AT LEAST 6 FEET APART. You must allow for time between scheduled clients to clean and sanitize touchpoints and contact surfaces. If you are able to reschedule a client for a later date, that would be preferred. We do not want anyone lingering in the waiting area for their appointment; if necessary ask them to wait outside and you can contact them after the previous customer has left and the station area sanitized.

At this time all public, private, parochial, and Amish schools are ordered closed by the Governor of Indiana and shall remain closed until May 1, 2020.

The Daviess County Health Department office is requiring only two persons at a time for immunization appointments.

Furthermore, if you are wanting in-person assistance for birth records, death records, environmental services (food, septic, etc.) or other in-person business, please call before coming to the office to schedule an appointment. Our main office number is (812) 254-8666.

Childcare providers are considered an essential service allowing for those workers that must be at their place of business for the benefit of the public in general (first responders, medical staff, supply chain personnel, etc.) to have a safe place to leave their children. Therefore, in accordance with the recommendations of the State of Indiana, childcare facilities will remain open at this time with additional guidelines. We are awaiting the guidance document detailing the additional guidelines from the State and will post a picture of it as soon as it is received.
