At the time of this posting, Daviess County has No positive test results for COVID-19.

HOWEVER, healthcare providers throughout Daviess County have informed many residents to self-quarantine due to symptoms of fever, headache, body aches, sore throat, runny nose, cough, etc.

We continue to relay the same message to the public as always: Practice social distancing, handwashing, frequent cleaning of surfaces, staying home, and isolating yourself if you are sick for at least 14 days.
