DAVIESS COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT REPORTS SECOND AND THIRD DEATH AND A TOTAL OF 31 CONFIRMED POSITIVE CASES (NO ADDITIONAL CONFIRMED CASES) OF COVID-19

The Daviess County Health Department announces as of the time of this release, there has been a second and third death and there are a total of 31 confirmed positive cases (no additional confirmed positive cases) of novel coronavirus (COVID-19) in Daviess County.

DCHD is working closely with the local and state officials to ensure that close contacts of the patients are identified and monitored and that all infection control protocols are being followed.

The patients have been placed in quarantine. No additional information about the patients or deaths will be released due to privacy laws.

The best way to protect yourself from any respiratory illness, including the flu, is to:

· **Stay home**

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.

- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact (within 6 feet) with people who are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
