DAVIESS COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT REPORTS A TOTAL OF SEVENTEEN (17) DEATHS AND A TOTAL OF 54 CONFIRMED POSITIVE CASES OF COVID-19

The Daviess County Health Department announces as of the time of this release, a total of seventeen (17) deaths and a total of 54 confirmed positive cases of novel coronavirus (COVID-19) in Daviess County.

The patients have been placed in quarantine. No additional information about the patients or deaths will be released due to privacy laws.

Signs and symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- Loss of taste and/or smell
- Fever greater than 100.4 degrees
- Abdominal pain
- Nausea and/or vomiting
- Chest pain
- Chills
- Sore throat
- Tiredness beyond normal
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Diarrhea
- Muscle aches
- Headache

How to best protect yourself from contracting COVID-19 during stage two starting 5/4/20:

- If over 65 or high-risk medical conditions – STAY HOME
- Recommend wearing face coverings in public settings
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- Limit social gatherings to no more than 25 people
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
- Avoid close contact with people – maintain at least a six (6) foot separation
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces
