DAVIESS COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT REPORTS NEW TESTING SITES FOR COVID-19 WILL BE AVAILABLE STARTING WEDNESDAY, MAY 6TH. INDIVIDUALS SEEKING TESTING MUST BE SYMPTOMATIC TO BE ELIGIBLE AND MUST SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT

During the Governor's news conference on Monday, May 4, 2020, it was announced a new testing site map is located on the www.coronavirus.in.gov website. This is a living map and will be updated daily as clinics open or close. It will show locations of drive-thru and fixed COVID-19 testing sites around the state and will reflect the 20 sites announced for the first wave of the testing partnership between Indiana and OptumServe.

The map shows the locations of the Optum clinics in Indiana counties. An additional 30 sites are being finalized, and that information will be updated on the map as it becomes available.
