RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DAVIESS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A COMMUNITY COORDINATOR POSITION AND THE ALLOCATION OF \$20,000 TO CREATE THIS POSITION SHOULD DAVIESS COUNTY BE A HELP-DESIGNATED COMMUNITY

WHEREAS, the Daviess County Board of Commissioners recognizes the effect of the Coronavirus public health crisis on the citizens of Daviess County.

WHEREAS, the Daviess County Board of Commissioners receives funds from the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, created under the American Rescue Plan Act, passed by the current administration; and

WHEREAS, the Daviess County Board of Commissioners, will apply to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs for the Hoosier Enduring Legacy Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Daviess County Board of Commissioners, that:


1. The Daviess County Board of Commissioners is authorized to elect a team to conduct interviews to fill a Community Coordinator position as outlined in the job description provided by the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs./The Bedrock Chief Elected Official is authorized to shift the priorities of a current employee to devote at least thirty hours of their work week to the responsibilities of the Community Coordinator position as outlined in the job description provided by the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.
2. The Daviess County Council hereby commits local funds to be determined but not less than the amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000), from Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, for the starting salary of the Community Coordinator Position, to be matched with Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) by the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs. Such commitment is to be contingent upon recognition as a HELP-designated community provided by the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.
