Alternative P is the Preferred Alternative for the Mid-States Corridor, recommended in the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS).

Begins at I-64/US 231 interchange	Travels east of Huntingburg and Jasper	Runs parallel to and west of US 231 in Martin and Daviess counties
Includes western bypass of Loogootee	Ends at I-69 interchange at US 231	Includes 9 local improvements along existing US 231

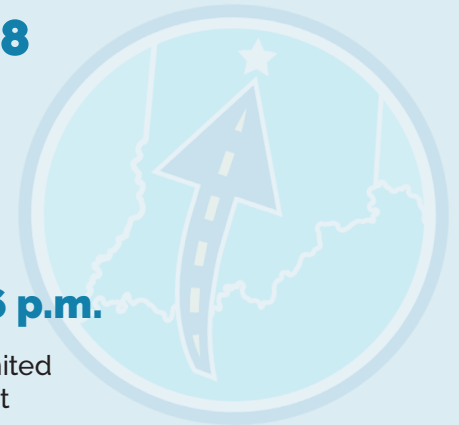
Public hearings are being held near Crane, IN and in Jasper, IN.
